7. Ride groups limited to 6 people

Maximum of six riders in groups is the maximum permitted under present guidelines.

8. Future maximum size of groups

This can only change when government decisions allow.

Leading groups of 12 or more people can be challenging.

Decision

Future meetings will consider this topic when guidelines allow larger groups.

9. Running multiple rides separated by time, speed, distance, route, coffee stops

Suggestions included restarting picnic rides.

Preferred days for rides were Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday.

Rides can be arranged on other days

Suitable start points include Vivary Park (bandstand), Bishops Hull Church (garden by car park), In front of Brewhouse.

French Weir outside Weir cafe has become too busy - an alternative meeting point nearby could be considered.

Decision

Several rides can be started on same day if they have different start points/ coffee stops / routes

10. All rides to be generic club rides for up to October

For the next few months named group rides (e.g. Ladies/ Weir/ midweek) will be suspended while we concentrate on building up a series of small group rides of up to 6 riders

11. New IT lead

Ross stepped down as IT lead at last AGM. AGM requested members who understood IT to consider volunteering for this role. Richard has offered to help Jonathan with running of the website.

Decision

Richard appointed as new IT lead.
